The report identified the following good practice examples since implementing Calgary's Water Management Strategic Plan in 2007: 1100 of 2500 irrigated sites are managed with a centralized Motorola Control System that is the largest in North America, and has reduced water consumption by 30%. The 2012 Carlye Report benchmarked Calgary against 12 other cities using the same system & Calgary used 40% less water than the median cities. Additionally, the average cost of water was 57% lower than the next lowest agency.	www.calgary.ca

The report identified the following good practice examples since implementing Calgary's Urban Forestry Management Strategic Plan in 2007: approval of injection & barrier traps to manage pests, the introduction of a tree protection bylaw, introduction of water bags & drip irrigation to water trees, use of capital funds to resource the poplar life-cycle program, and the significant community involvement to build and expand the urban forest through the NeighbourWoods program.

Calgary was benchmarked with 6 North American cities and ranked the top for provision of pathways, snow clearing of the largest network, conduction annual infrastructure inspections & life cycle repairs -since 2010, Failure rate has declined to 2.2% from 5% (Pathway Safety Audit 2010).	www.calgary.ca
